MEMBERSHIP OF DUBLIN FOOD CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETY

Registered in Dublin with the Registrar of Friendly Societies. Regd. No. 4638R.

All new applicants for membership of the Society (and any former member lapsed for more than 1 year) must purchase a €1 share and pay the appropriate fee.

Individual Membership (€25, €12.50 concession)

This membership provides access to discount for an individual and his/her family (one additional family member may be named on the card). Only the first named individual is a shareholder-member with the right to participate in activities and attend and vote at Society meetings.

Household Membership (€40 / €20 concession)

Entitles two named people at the same address to each hold a share, a membership card and full rights to participate in activities and attend and vote at Society meetings. Each individual must purchase a share and complete a separate membership form. (Household memberships are, in practice, two individual memberships offered at a discounted rate). Individual membership can be upgraded to household membership at any time by a second person from a household purchasing a share and taking up membership at the appropriate add-on rate.

The Co-op's membership year runs January to December. All joiners after the first quarter pay a reduced, part-year fee for the remainder of the year. All renewals are due in January.

A discount of 50% on membership fees may be granted to members or applicants who produce for inspection a student or OAP card or evidence that they are in receipt of social welfare payments.

All applicants for membership should fill out the accompanying form and hand it into the Co-op Welcome Desk with their share and subscription payment.

The receipt issued will serve as an interim proof of membership and should be shown on request. Membership cards will normally be available for collection from the Welcome Desk two weeks after the date of joining.
